- COST -

- SEQUENCE -

TIME	STEP	DESCRIPTION
10 AM – 11 AM	Team Check in. Turn in all player's signed waivers.	Teams will get their wristbands after paying in full for the tournament. Please do not lose your team's wrist bands as we will NOT replace them.
11:00 AM	Coaches & Captains' meeting.	
11:30 AM	All teams report to the court.	
12:00 PM	Tournament starts.	Each team will play a minimum of 4 games each.
4:00 PM	Tournament ends.	

LEZVOLLEY RULES P.1

- MATCHES/POOL PLAY -
- SEMI-FINALS MATCHES -
- CHAMPIONSHIP -

We'll update as we finalize numbers of teams.

- TEAM CAPTAINS -

The team captain will be the only person to discuss issues with officials.
The captain or coach will be in charge of calling time-outs, substitutions etc.

- SUBSTITUTIONS -

Teams are allowed an unlimited number of substitutions.
Substitutions are ONLY allowed when the team has the ball before serving.

- SERVICE -

The ball shall be hit with one hand or any part of the arm, and does not have to be tossed or released from the hand(s) before being contacted.

- BALL TOUCHING THE NET -

The ball may touch the net while crossing it through the crossing space.
"Let Serve" rule.

- TIME OUTS -

Each team is allowed two time outs per game (30 seconds in length).

- BLOCKING CONTACT -

Only players in the front row may block.

- CONTACT WITH THE NET OR POSTS -

It is a fault for a player or a player's clothing to touch any part of the net. Exceptions are:

- Incidental contact of the net by a player's hair.
- If a player's hat visor or glasses fall off during play and then contacts the net.
- When a ball is driven into the net or the wind blows the net and causes the net to touch a player, no fault is committed.

Once a player has contacted the ball, the player may touch the posts, ropes, or any other object outside the total length of the net, provided that it does not interfere with play.

LEZVOLLEY RULES P.2

- ROTATION/SUBSTITUTION -

Teams may choose to either substitute or rotate (but cannot do both) at the start of a match. For teams choosing substitution, unlimited substitutions are allowed, but substitutions must be proper substitutions.

- SERVICE ATTEMPT -

One toss only is permissible. At the time the ball is contacted for service, the placement of players on the court must conform to the service order.

- ATTACK-HIT -

Back row players may not attack the ball above the plane of the net.
We do not have the ability to designate a 10-foot attack line, and therefore will not allow back row players to attack the ball above the plane of the net.

- SERVICE RECEIVE -

It is legal to receive a served ball using the fingers in a setting motion, provided that there is not a held ball.

- TEAM'S RESPONSIBILITIES -

- All teams must wear the same color tops with a number on the back or front.
- Each player signs a waiver.
- It is the coach's responsibility to ensure that the team is in place to play and has appointed 2 line judges (see tournament bracket).
- If your team is not on time to play any match, you will forfeit that match, and if your team is not on time to ref, you will forfeit your next match. A forfeit will be scored as 20-0.

- REMINDERS -

Please remember to clean up during the day. Be considerate of the environment as well as your fellow players and throw your trash away in bags along the beach. Each Team will be given a trash bag with their packet.

As you are all aware, it can be very humid. Even though we are on the ocean, please plan on a hot day.
Hydrate, hydrate, hydrate!
We also advise to bring socks as the sand tends to get very, very hot.
